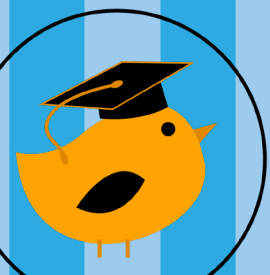

About This Pack

Sound bingo is great for spelling practice and as an alternative to spelling tests.

This pack includes bingo boards and words for twenty different phonemes. Each phoneme consists of a list of single-syllable and multisyllabic words. The words have been sorted into the various spellings for the phoneme focus.

Each bingo board provides the spellings at the top as a reference for students. However, you do not need to use all of the spellings if you are only focusing on a couple. Have your students cross out the spellings you don't want to use, then select the words that contain your spelling focus.

Some words include more than one way to spell the sound, for example, **silence**. Students can write the word into both the 's' and 'ce' space.

You can use the games in several different ways, including:

- Whole class.
- Independent practice in class.
- Small group work.
- Part of a literacy station.
- Review and remediation.
- Home practice and consolidation.



Progression Of Phonemes

The table below shows the progression of phonemes and their graphemes. You can use the bingo boards in order or pick and choose based on your weekly lessons and students' abilities.

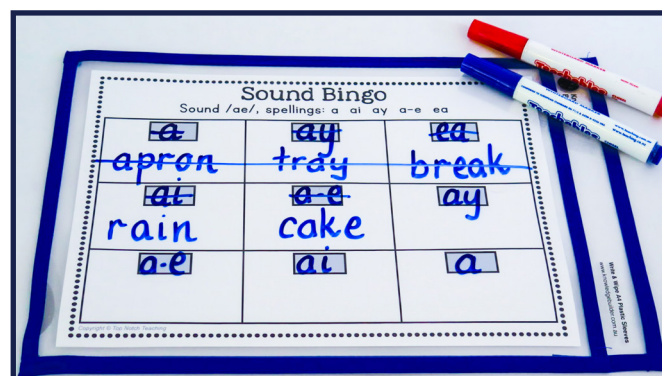
Bingo Instructions

Resources

- Copies of the bingo board for the phoneme you are focusing on.
- Set of bingo word cards for the phoneme focus; and
- Pens / pencils / whiteboard markers.

Steps

1. Copy the bingo board, so there are enough for all students. To reuse the boards, laminate them or put them in a plastic sleeve or dry erase pocket.
2. Copy and cut the bingo word cards. Use the words that suit the level of your students. Single-syllable words and multi-syllable words are provided. The words are also sorted into their spelling for the phoneme focus to help you select words that suit the level of your students.
3. Provide each student with a bingo board.
4. Students write one of each of the spellings on the board in random squares. They repeat the spellings until all the squares contain a spelling for the sound.
5. The teacher randomly chooses words and calls them out.
6. Students select a square with the correct spelling for the word. They write the word in the square and then cross out the spelling.
7. Students call bingo when they have three words in a row (vertical, horizontal or diagonal) or when all squares are filled.
8. For a student to win, all words need to be spelled correctly.
