

- 2. /d/, /t/ and /id/


There are also word posters for each suffix. Use the posters for display in your classroom and fluc corpractice Enlarge the posters to A3 (ledger) size and then larger the for carability.


There are well calls in ling the base words and suffixes -ed and -ing) the outen use for sorting activities, games, reading practice, or addition to your sound wall (or word wall).






